TYPES OF ATOMIC ORBITALS

THERE ARE FOUR PRIMARY TYPES OF ATOMIC ORBITALS, EACH WITH DISTINCT SHAPES AND ENERGY CHARACTERISTICS:

- **S-ORBITALS:** SPHERICAL IN SHAPE, THESE ORBITALS CAN HOLD UP TO TWO ELECTRONS.

ENERGY LEVEL HIERARCHY

THE ENERGY OF ORBITALS WITHIN AN ATOM IS NOT STRICTLY SEQUENTIAL ACCORDING TO PRINCIPAL QUANTUM NUMBER ALONE. INSTEAD, IT FOLLOWS AN ESTABLISHED ORDER INFLUENCED BY ELECTRON-ELECTRON INTERACTIONS AND NUCLEAR ATTRACTION. THE GENERAL SEQUENCE IS 1s, 2s, 2p, 3s, 3p, 4s, 3d, 4p, AND SO FORTH. FOR ARGON, WHOSE ELECTRONS FILL UP TO THE 3p ORBITAL, THIS ORDERING DETERMINES THE FINAL DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRONS AND IS ILLUSTRATED CLEARLY IN ITS ORBITAL ENERGY DIAGRAM.

ELECTRON CONFIGURATION OF ARGON

THE ELECTRON CONFIGURATION OF ARGON IS FUNDAMENTAL TO UNDERSTANDING ITS ORBITAL ENERGY DIAGRAM. ARGON, WITH AN ATOMIC NUMBER OF 18, POSSESSES 18 ELECTRONS ARRANGED IN SHELLS AND SUBSHELLS FOLLOWING THE ENERGY MINIMIZATION PRINCIPLES. THE ELECTRON CONFIGURATION IS OFTEN WRITTEN AS $1s^2 2s^2 2p^6 3s^2 3p^6$, INDICATING FULLY FILLED INNER SHELLS AND A COMPLETE OUTER SHELL, WHICH ACCOUNTS FOR ARGON'S CHEMICAL INERTNESS.

FILLING ORDER OF ELECTRONS IN ARGON

THE FILLING OF ELECTRONS IN ARGON PROCEEDS ACCORDING TO THE AUFBAU PRINCIPLE, WHERE ELECTRONS OCCUPY THE LOWEST ENERGY ORBITALS AVAILABLE BEFORE MOVING TO HIGHER LEVELS:

1. TWO ELECTRONS FILL THE 1s ORBITAL ($1s^2$).
2. TWO ELECTRONS FILL THE 2s ORBITAL ($2s^2$).
3. SIX ELECTRONS FILL THE 2p ORBITALS ($2p^6$).
4. TWO ELECTRONS FILL THE 3s ORBITAL ($3s^2$).
5. SIX ELECTRONS FILL THE 3p ORBITALS ($3p^6$).

STABILITY FROM ELECTRON CONFIGURATION

ARGON'S FULLY FILLED S AND P ORBITALS IN ITS OUTERMOST SHELL CONFER EXCEPTIONAL STABILITY. THIS CLOSED-SHELL CONFIGURATION RESULTS IN MINIMAL CHEMICAL REACTIVITY, CHARACTERISTIC OF NOBLE GASES. THE ARGON ORBITAL ENERGY DIAGRAM GRAPHICALLY REPRESENTS THIS STABILITY BY SHOWING THE COMPLETE FILLING OF ENERGY LEVELS WITHOUT PARTIALLY OCCUPIED ORBITALS THAT MIGHT OTHERWISE FACILITATE BONDING.

STRUCTURE OF THE ARGON ORBITAL ENERGY DIAGRAM
