ACCESSORY ORGANS SUPPORT DIGESTION LABELED BY PRODUCING ENZYMES, BILE, AND HORMONES:

- **LIVER:** PRODUCES BILE TO EMULSIFY FATS.
- **PANCREAS:** SECRETES DIGESTIVE ENZYMES AND BICARBONATE TO NEUTRALIZE STOMACH ACID.
- **GALLBLADDER:** STORES AND CONCENTRATES BILE, RELEASING IT INTO THE SMALL INTESTINE AS NEEDED.

STAGES OF DIGESTION

DIGESTION LABELED INVOLVES MULTIPLE STAGES THAT ENSURE FOOD IS EFFECTIVELY BROKEN DOWN AND NUTRIENTS ARE ABSORBED. INGESTION AND PROPULSION

INGESTION IS THE INTAKE OF FOOD THROUGH THE MOUTH, WHERE MECHANICAL DIGESTION BEGINS WITH CHEWING. PROPULSION INVOLVES SWALLOWING AND THE MOVEMENT OF FOOD THROUGH THE DIGESTIVE TRACT VIA MUSCULAR CONTRACTIONS CALLED PERISTALSIS, WHICH MOVES FOOD FROM THE ESOPHAGUS TO THE STOMACH AND ONWARDS.

MECHANICAL AND CHEMICAL DIGESTION

MECHANICAL DIGESTION INCLUDES PHYSICAL PROCESSES SUCH AS CHEWING AND STOMACH CHURNING THAT BREAK FOOD INTO SMALLER PIECES. CHEMICAL DIGESTION REFERS TO ENZYMATIC REACTIONS THAT BREAK DOWN MACROMOLECULES LIKE CARBOHYDRATES, PROTEINS, AND LIPIDS INTO ABSORBABLE UNITS.

ABSORPTION AND DEFECATION

ABSORPTION PRIMARILY OCCURS IN THE SMALL INTESTINE, WHERE NUTRIENTS PASS THROUGH THE INTESTINAL LINING INTO THE BLOODSTREAM. DEFECATION IS THE FINAL STAGE WHERE INDIGESTIBLE SUBSTANCES AND WASTE PRODUCTS ARE ELIMINATED THROUGH THE RECTUM AND ANUS.

ENZYMES AND CHEMICAL DIGESTION

PROTEIN DIGESTION

PROTEIN DIGESTION STARTS IN THE STOMACH WHERE PEPSIN BREAKS DOWN PROTEINS INTO PEPTIDES. FURTHER BREAKDOWN OCCURS IN THE SMALL INTESTINE THROUGH PANCREATIC PROTEASES LIKE TRYPSIN AND CHYMOTRYPSIN, PRODUCING AMINO ACIDS READY FOR ABSORPTION.

LIPID DIGESTION

LIPID DIGESTION IS FACILITATED BY BILE FROM THE LIVER, WHICH EMULSIFIES FATS, INCREASING THE SURFACE AREA FOR PANCREATIC LIPASE TO BREAK TRIGLYCERIDES INTO FATTY ACIDS AND GLYCEROL.

ABSORPTION AND NUTRIENT TRANSPORT

ONCE DIGESTION LABELED BREAKS DOWN FOOD INTO BASIC NUTRIENTS, ABSORPTION IS CRITICAL FOR TRANSPORTING THESE NUTRIENTS INTO THE BLOODSTREAM OR LYMPHATIC SYSTEM. THE SMALL INTESTINE'S MUCOSAL LINING CONTAINS VILLI AND MICROVILLI, INCREASING SURFACE AREA FOR MAXIMAL ABSORPTION.

MECHANISMS OF ABSORPTION

NUTRIENTS ARE ABSORBED THROUGH VARIOUS MECHANISMS INCLUDING PASSIVE DIFFUSION, FACILITATED DIFFUSION, ACTIVE TRANSPORT, AND ENDOCYTOSIS. CARBOHYDRATES AND AMINO ACIDS TYPICALLY USE ACTIVE TRANSPORT, WHILE LIPIDS ENTER LYMPHATIC VESSELS VIA CHYLOMICRONS.

NUTRIENT TRANSPORT SYSTEMS

AFTER ABSORPTION, NUTRIENTS ENTER THE CIRCULATORY OR LYMPHATIC SYSTEMS. WATER-SOLUBLE VITAMINS, MINERALS, AND AMINO ACIDS ENTER THE BLOODSTREAM DIRECTLY, WHEREAS FATS ARE TRANSPORTED THROUGH THE LYMPHATIC SYSTEM BEFORE REACHING THE BLOODSTREAM.

COMMON DIGESTIVE DISORDERS
