THE GUIDED READING ACTIVITY WOULD LIKELY ASK STUDENTS TO COMPARE AND CONTRAST THESE VIEWPOINTS AND EXPLAIN WHY THE PERCEIVED CHAOS OR INCONVENIENCE OF THE STATE OF NATURE LED TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF GOVERNMENTS. ## EARLY FORMS OF SOCIAL ORGANIZATION

## THE ROLE OF CITIZENS IN EARLY GOVERNANCE
